Chamberlain Place Senior Housing, a Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) property, managed by The Housing Authority of the City of Brewer (BHA), features the following apartments: 28 one-bedrooms and 4 two-bedrooms for individuals who are **55 years of age and older**. This property includes a community room, raised garden beds, coin-op laundry machines on each floor, and on-site reserved parking. Rents are restricted by income and include electric, heat, domestic hot water, sewer, water, laundry hook-up in apartment, and basic internet access. Chamberlain Place is a **smoke free property**.

As of October, 2022 – applicants whose names appear on a public housing or Section 8 waiting list will receive preference when renting these units.

To qualify, applicants' yearly income must fall below the annual income limit determined by HUD. Please see the chart below to see how this applies to your household. Note that tenant-based vouchers will be accepted, such as Section 8 – HCV, Shelter + Care, etc.
